# Directions to Woodland Park Zoo's West Entry

# <u>By Car</u>

**From the South / Downtown** Take I-5 north to N.E. 50th Street (Exit #169). Go west to Phinney Avenue, turn right and drive north to 5500 Phinney Avenue.

**From the North** take I-5 south to NE 50th Street (Exit #169). Go west to Phinney Avenue, turn right and drive north to 5500 Phinney Avenue.

## By Bus and Bike

#### From the Downtown/South

Take Metro Transit #5 north from 3rd Ave. and Pine St. to the zoo's West Entrance at N. 55th St. and Phinney Ave N. (timetable for #5 bus).

#### From Ballard/University District

Take Metro Transit #44 east from Ballard Ave. NW. toward Montlake. Exit at the intersection of N. 46th Street and Phinney Ave. You may either transfer to the #5 bus which stops near the zoo's West Entrance (N. 55th St. and Phinney Ave. N.) or walk approximately .44 miles to the West Entrance. (timetable for #44 bus).

## By Bike:

Bike racks are provided at each zoo entrance and Phinney Ave. has bike lanes for your safety. Visit the City of Seattle's site for <u>local bike routes</u>.

# <u>Parking</u>

Pay-for-parking kiosks are located at each lot.

- \$5.00 per day for cars
- \$15.00 for buses, RVs and other oversize vehicles.

## The zoo has five parking lots:

- West Entrance ("Water Tower lot") at the intersection of N. 50th St. and Phinney Ave. N.
- West Entrance at Phinney Ave. N. and N. 55th St.
- South Entrance at the intersection of N. 50th St. and Fremont Ave. N.
- North lot at N. 59th St. and Evanston Ave. The West Entrance is accessible from a pathway from the north parking lot.
- An inner north lot located at 57th. Come to the Evanston and N. 59th Street entrance to the zoo, continue west and the entrance will be located on the left side of the road before you go under the Phinney Ave. overpass.
