

# EMMA SCHMITZ MEMORIAL OVERLOOK SEAWALL PROJECT

Seattle Parks and Recreation and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers invite the community to an Open House to learn about the Emma Schmitz Seawall Replacement project. Please join us for a short presentation followed by an Open House.

The seawall is located at Emma Schmitz Memorial Overlook, 4503 Beach Dr. SW, Seattle, WA 98116. The new seawall will be a “soldier pile” design, built a few feet seaward and a few feet higher than the existing seawall, and equipped with safety handrails that the current seawall lacks. This design will minimize the impact on the beach, address rising seawater concerns, and create better contours for the restoration landscaping on the landward portion of the overlook area. We anticipate construction in mid-2020.
