




Gaps in Usable Open Space in the Northwest Sector, 2005

- Service Area Criteria for Usable Open Space (UOS)**
- ProParks Levy
 - 1/8 Mile Service Area of Usable Open Space over 1/4 Acre
- UOS of 1/4 Acre or more for Urban Centers and Hub Urban Villages accessible within 1/8 mile
 - ProParks Levy
 - 1/4 Mile Service Area of Usable Open Space over 1/4 Acre
- UOS of 1/4 Acre or more for Residential Urban Villages, depending on population density, accessible within 1/8 to 1/4 mile
 - ProParks Levy
 - 1/2 Mile Service Area of Usable Open Space over 1/2 Acre
- UOS of 1/2 Acre or more for Single Family areas accessible within 1/2 mile
