The project manager will present information and answer questions on the upcoming park improvements which include the installation of new retaining walls and pathway widening, pathway removals, and plant restoration.

We also want to discuss options for the arbor located south of the play area.

Bhy Kracke Park is located at 1215 5th Ave. N. The play area will be closed for a portion of the construction while the walls behind it are built.

We anticipate starting the project in late summer 2017 with completion by fall 2017. The community is encouraged to come and give input on Bhy Kracke Park improvements.
