

PORTAGE BAY PARK PUBLIC MEETING

Seattle Parks and Recreation invites the community to review the schematic design for the development of a new park at 1101-1137 NE Boat Street on Portage Bay. Seattle Parks purchased the Bryant Marina site from the University of Washington in 2014 and is moving forward to develop a waterfront park for the community. The goal of the project is to provide upland and shoreline/water-related recreational experiences for all ages and abilities. The development will include remediation of site contamination, building demolition and potential partial re-use of building elements and shoreline enhancement.

Seattle Parks and Recreation and the design team have incorporated community feedback from previous meetings into the schematic design. This meeting is an opportunity for the community to learn more about the project and provide input on the final design.

We encourage all families, students, and neighbors to attend and participate in the planning of this new waterfront park.
