### A. DETAILED PROJECT SCOPE

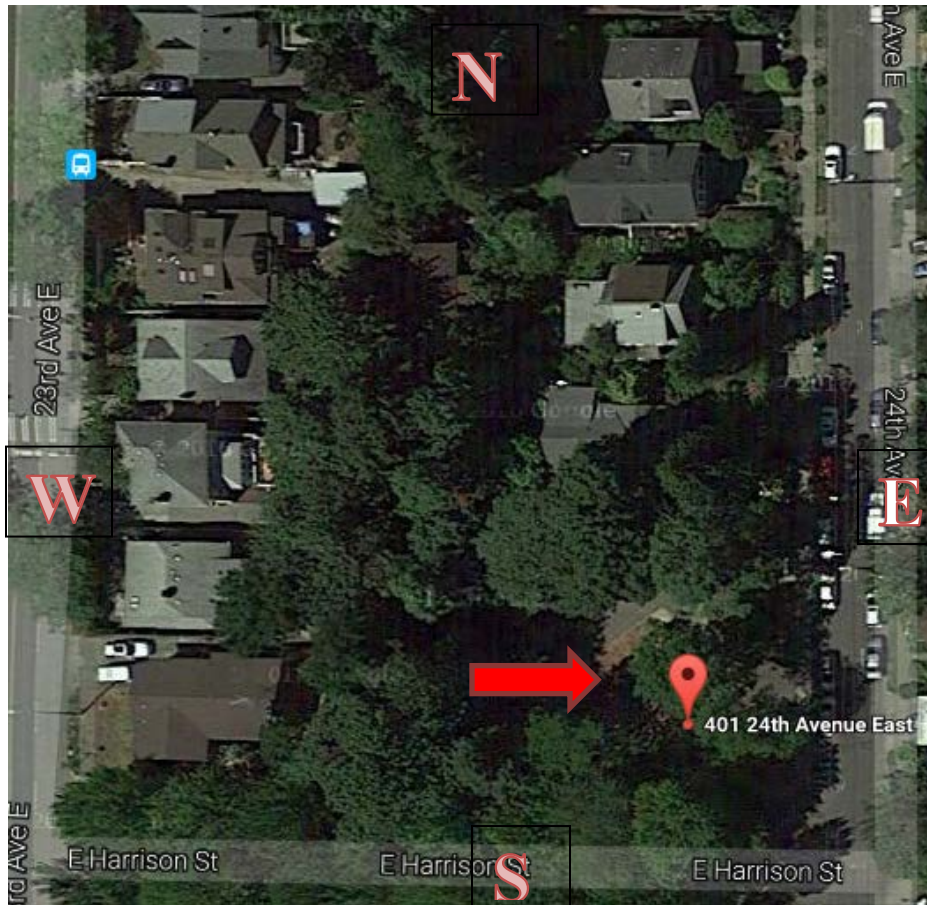
