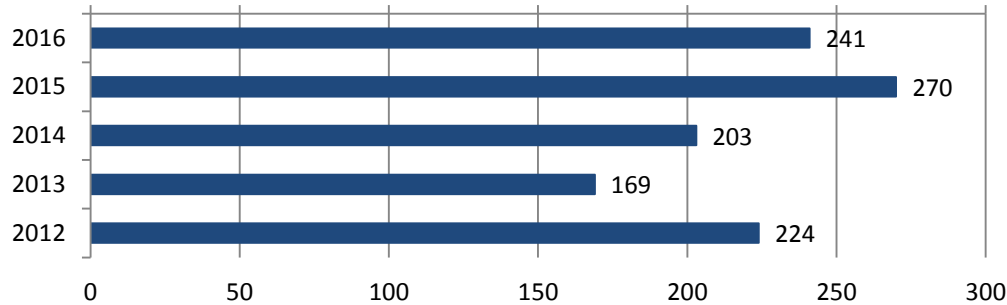

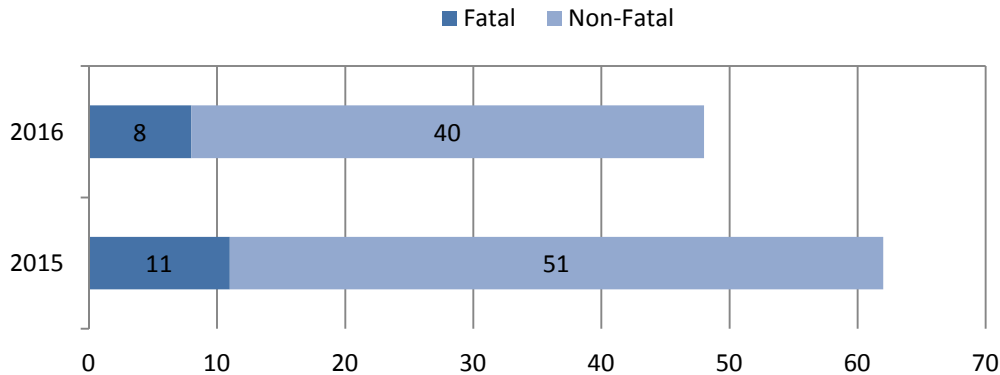

January 1 to August 29 (2015 and 2016)

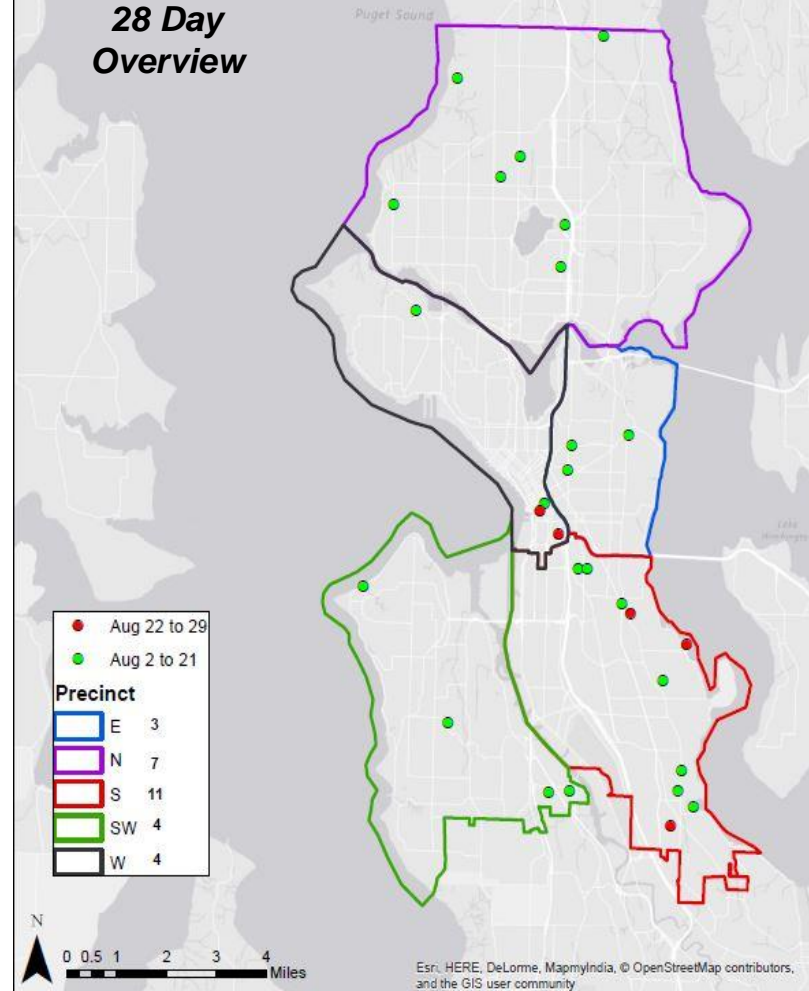

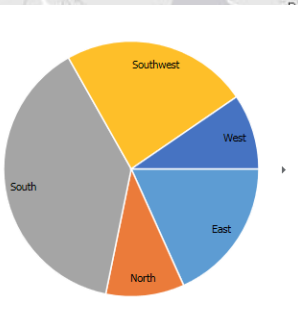
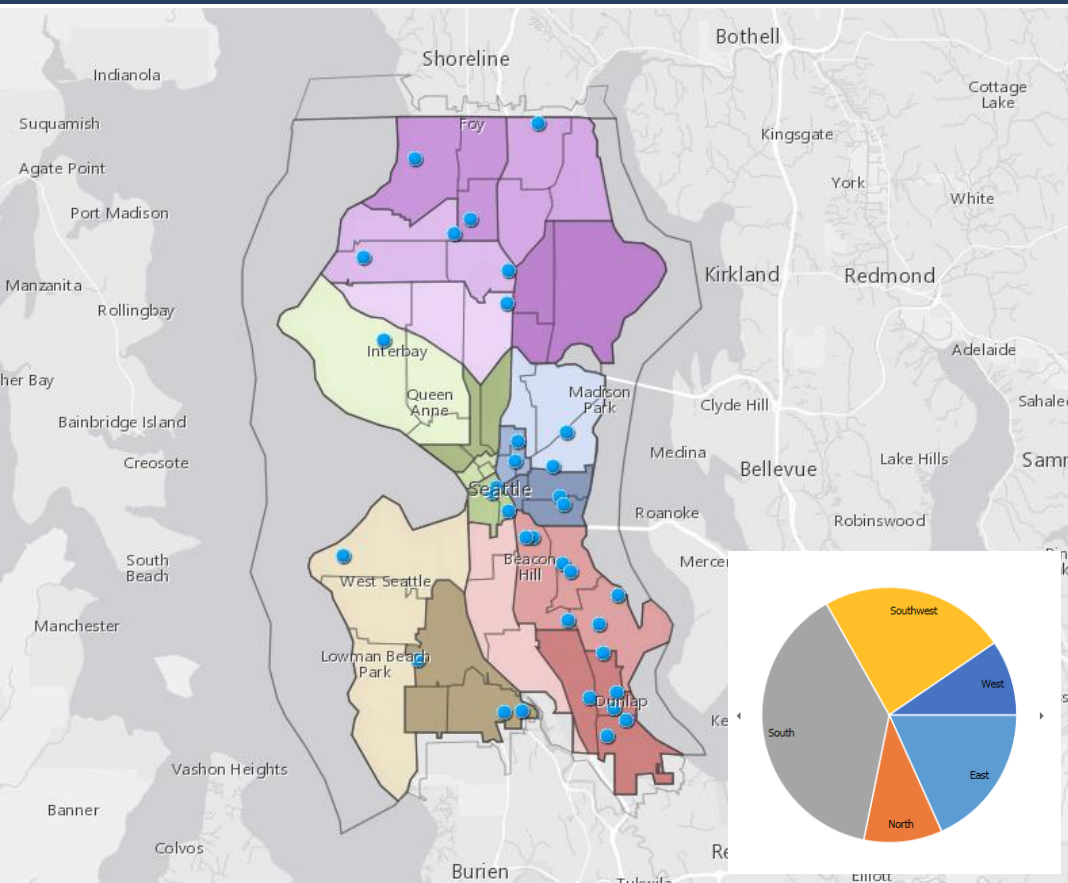

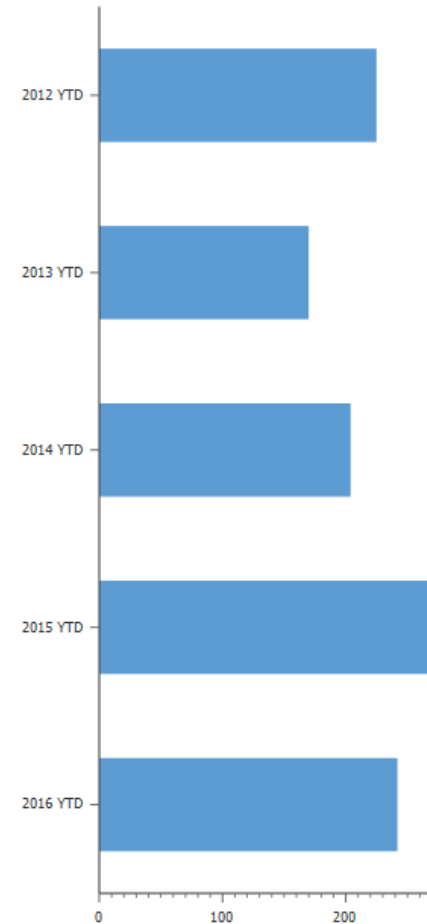


# SHOTS FIRED DASHBOARD
