- *Repeat and Vulnerable Victims*



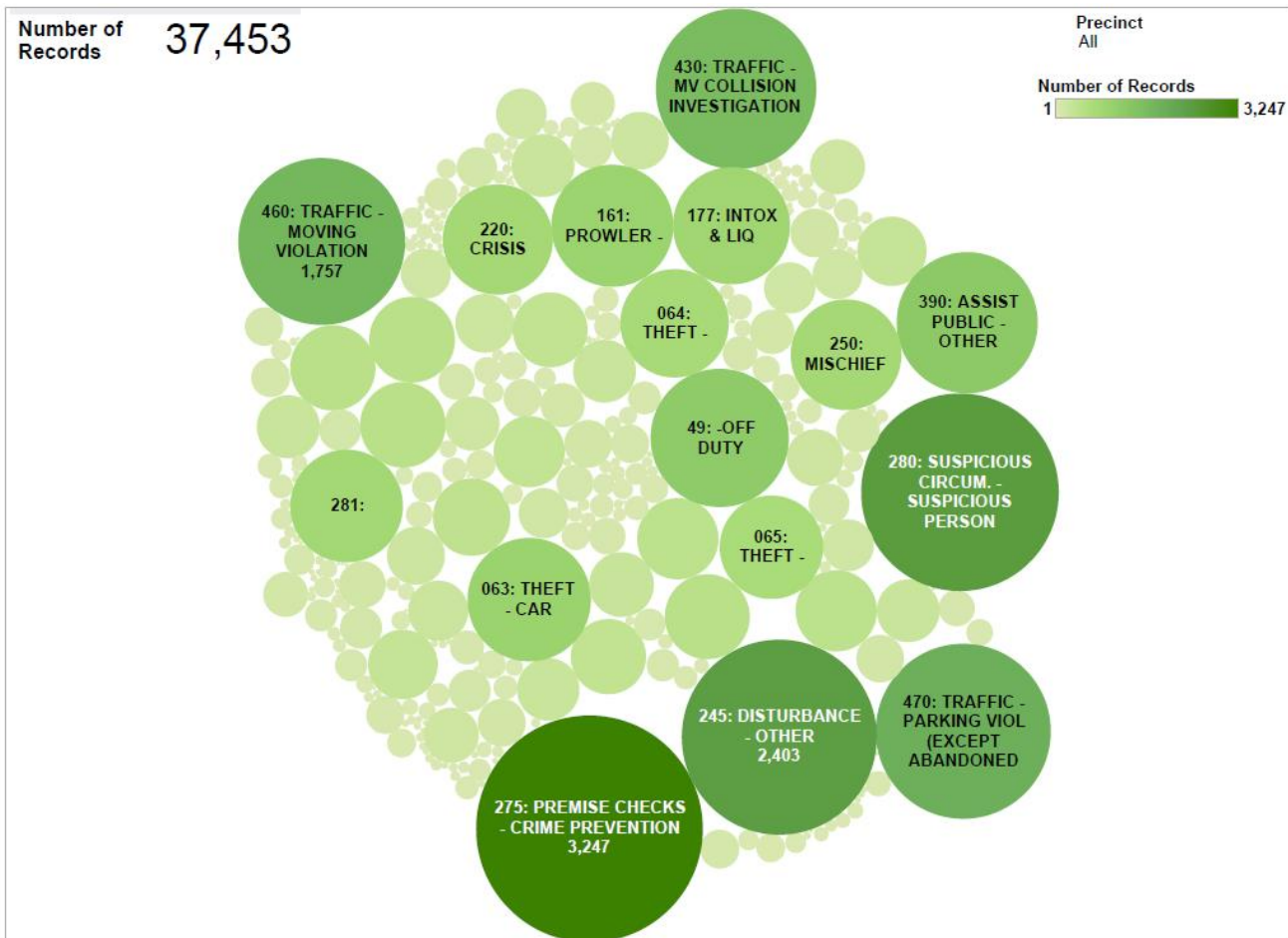

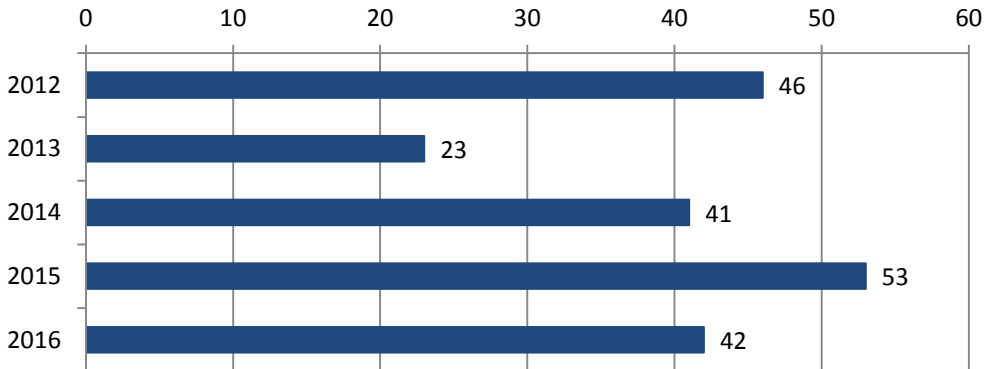

CITYWIDE CAD: JANUARY 2016

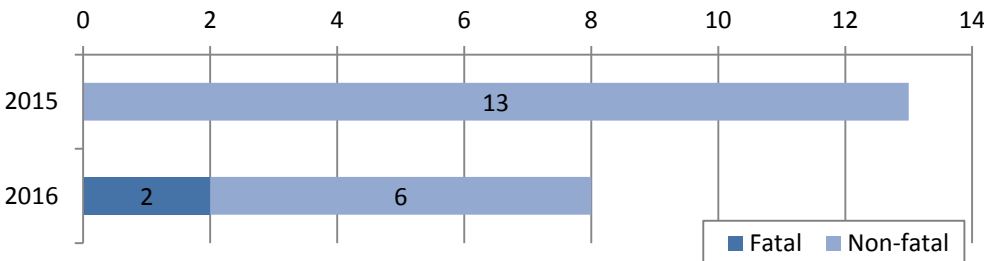


SHOTS FIRED

January 1 to February 15: 2015 and 2016

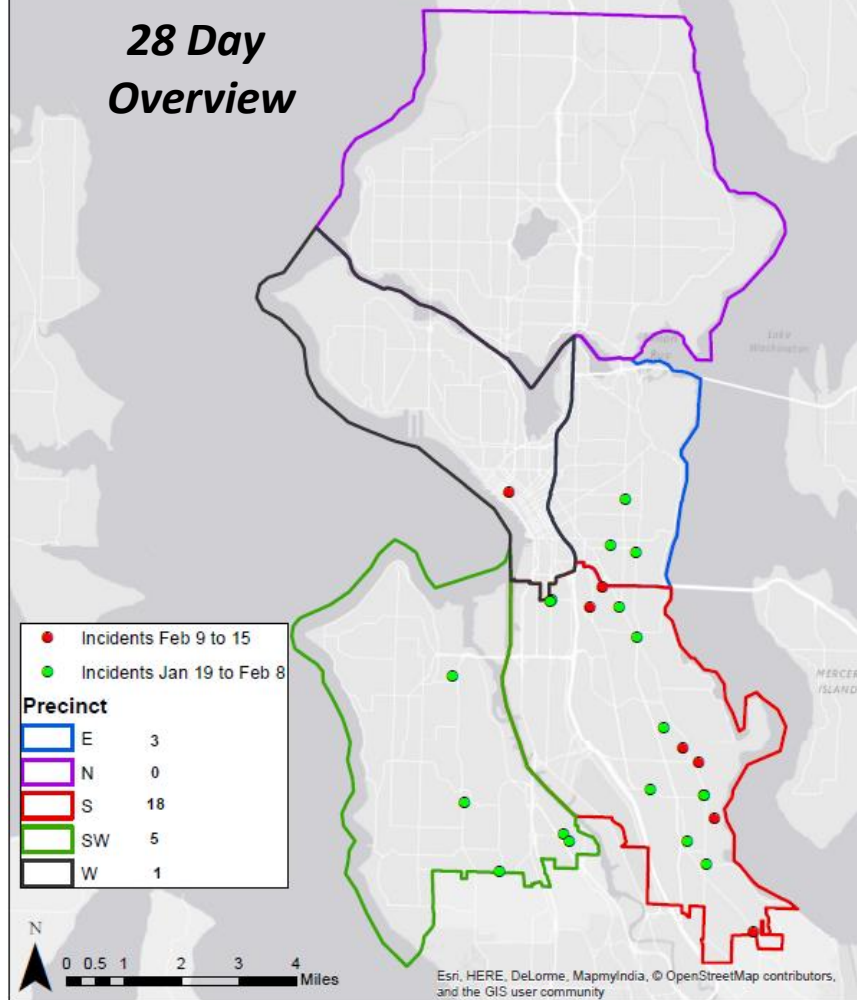
