




Aggravated Assault January to September 2014




9 Month Overview January to September (2014 compared to 2013)

 Aggravated Assault from 2013


Aggravated Assault for the City of Seattle January to September (2013 and 2014)




Auto Theft for the City of Seattle 9 Month Overview: January to September 2008-2014




Auto Theft for the City of Seattle 9 Month Overview: January to September 2013 and 2014




Auto Theft Percentage by Precinct January 1 to October 25, 2014




Auto Theft Density by Precinct January 1 to October 25, 2014

Hot Spot Location #2


North Precinct (N 80th-93rd St & Palatine-Ashworth Ave N) 16 Incidents Primarily Friday and Saturday overnight




Westwood Village CAD Calls Jan 2011 to Oct 2014






