If it works, do more. If not, do something else







December 7, 2014 to January 3, 2015 (N=291)




Citywide Auto Theft: Hot Spot Analysis December 7, 2014 to January 3, 2015







EAST PRECINCT: CAR PROWL



28 Day Analysis

- 213 Car Prowls Precinct Wide
- 51 (24%) occurred in identified Hot Spot
- Targeted Areas:
 - QFC Parking Lot (above and below building)
 - Pay Lot at Broadway and E Union St.

Problem Location

Consistent Hot Spot over time. 28% of all East Precinct Car Prowls from Jan-Oct of last year
