

FIREARMS TAKEN INTO CUSTODY


Firearms Taken into Custody by Year January 1 to August 31 (2010-2015)

Firearms are obtained through civilian turn-ins, surrenders, found property, and criminal investigations.




CITYWIDE SHOTS FIRED






Shootings by Injury Type January 1 to September 14 (2014 and 2015)






