


CITYWIDE ROBBERY

January 4, 2015 to June 20, 2015




CITYWIDE NON DV AGGRAVATED ASSAULT

January 4, 2015 to June 20, 2015




Citywide Shots Fired YTD



- Suspect and /or Victim Intoxicated 7 (23%)












