

Registered Side Sewer Contractor (RSSC)

-- Registration Requirements--

To obtain a Side Sewer permit for work in the right-of-way (ROW) your company is required to become a Registered Side Sewer Contractor with the City of Seattle.

- Create an account on the Seattle Services Portal: <https://cosaccela.seattle.gov/portal/>
- All documents must consistently reflect the “full legal name” of the company.
- Once all the documents/fee have been received and approved, your company will become an official Registered Side Sewer Contractor.

REQUIREMENTS BELOW: will be verified by the RSSC Program staff. It is not necessary to provide a physical copy.

- **City of Seattle Business License** (expires annually on 12/31.)
- **WA State Contractor’s License.**

REQUIREMENTS BELOW: will be approved by the RSSC Program staff.

- **RSSC Agreement form:** Submit and pay online. Link to Agreement form: <http://www.seattle.gov/sdci/permits/forms>

Fees:

\$200 new contractors

\$150 annual renewal fee: due 12/31 each year

- **Bond in the amount of \$30,000.** Must submit the **original and it must be single-sided, we cannot accept a double-sided copy.** Link to instructions & form: <http://www.seattle.gov/sdci/permits/forms>
- **Certificate of Insurance:** Will be approved by Risk Management, email COI to sci_rssc_sidesewer@seattle.gov Link to COI requirements: <http://www.seattle.gov/sdci/permits/forms>
- **Certified Individual(s)** who have passed the RSSC exam and currently work for your company.

NOTE: notify us via email if a "certified individual" is hired OR leaves your company. If we do not have the correct names on file, a former employee could pull a permit on behalf of your company. Certified Individuals can obtain permits for your company and perform work in the ROW.

Authorized Individual(s): employees who work for your company that have not passed the RSSC Exam but can obtain side sewer permits on behalf of your company.

Active Status: If all documents/fees remain approved & current throughout the year, your company’s status is “Active”.

Inactive Status: If any documents/fees are not current. i.e., bond, insurance, licensing, registration fee or fees owed to SDCI, SDOT and/or SPU, your company’s status will be “Inactive”.
