Stairway replacement at Howe St between 5th Ave N & Bigelow Ave N

PROJECT UPDATE

To improve pedestrian safety and accessibility, Seattle Department of Transportation (SDOT) crews are replacing the stairway at Howe St between 5th Ave N & Bigelow Ave N.

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

Improvements include:

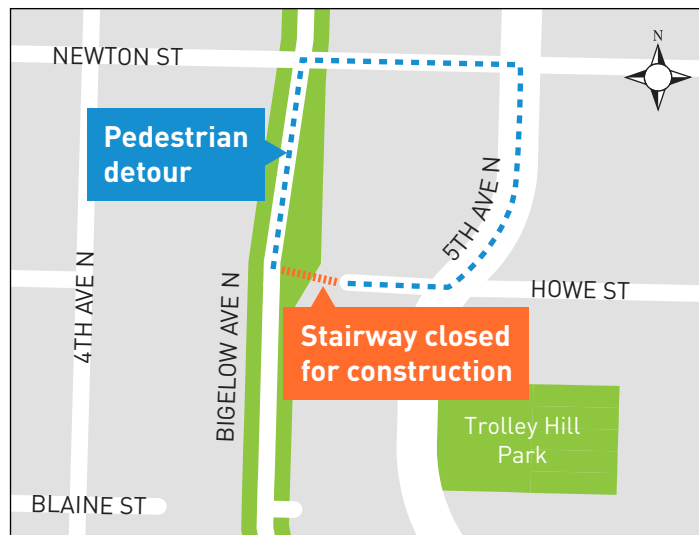
- Replacing the existing stairs with a new stairway made of reinforced concrete, with even heights for each step
- Installing new handrails on each side, with a second handrail at a lower height to accommodate adults and children

CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE

Work is scheduled for late April through mid-June, depending on weather. The stairway will be closed during most of the work. Please follow the posted detour route.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- Typical work hours between 7 AM and 3:30 PM on weekdays
- Intermittent parking restrictions at top and bottom of stairway during work
- Some noisy work activity including digging and backup alarms required for safety
