Questions

- Davis** Will the outcome of this process be a bridge? Are you considering alternatives to a bridge?
- Molloy** Did you explore improving the two other existing crossings to see if we could get 60,000 crossings a day?
- Miller** How is the Galer Street Overpass factored in? How many trips do the Galer Street Overpass handle in a day?
- Edwards** I'd hope that you'll be considering all kinds of options. I'd especially encourage you to look at not crossing the railroad tracks at-grade.
- Miller** Have you looked at southern route along Elliot Bay marina? Who chooses the final three alternatives? Who passes those recommendations to the city council? How do we give input on this process that will affect our property?
- Molloy** How long will it take to build a new bridge?
- Davis** We want to work closely with the city on the terminal 91 property. We hope the bridge TS&L study will compliment that work.
- Miller** How many months is this project?
- Molloy** Are tolls being considered to pay for the bridge?
- Miller** Are you open to suggestions beside replacing the existing bridge?
- Nordquist** I hope you'll explore an at-grade route that wouldn't require a bridge.
