

Subject: NSF Aurora Public Art: Final design update

Hello!

I'm writing to inform you that we've completed design for the Neighborhood Street Fund (NSF) Aurora Public Art project, which will add visual identity to the Aurora Licton Urban Village. If you were able to join us at the November 12 community open house hosted by our partners at Aurora Licton Urban Village (ALUV), you're familiar with [Vicki Scuri's](#) art installation coming to the pedestrian bridge at N 102nd (see image below). The [display boards](#) from that meeting provide additional information about Vicki's work and material for the bridge.

In late November 2017, Vicki's art concept received full Public Art Advisory Committee (PAAC) approval. Since then, she and the SDOT project team have been working on final details to incorporate her concepts into construction documents.

Project schedule

We expect to implement this art installation in late spring/summer 2018. We'll be in touch again later this spring with more details about the schedule and any anticipated construction impacts.
