


#### Data-driven policy

- Keep 1 to 2 spaces open per block throughout the day
- Collect data in all paid areas annually
- Make annual data-driven rate, hours of operation, and timelimit adjustments to meet City policy






### Ballard Locks Seasonal rates @ \$1/hour in October















#### Peak daytime occupancy – 95% Rate increase - \$3.00/hour




## Roosevelt 7 PM occupancy – 100% Add evening paid parking








