



30th Ave NE Sidewalks - Phase 2

Construction to begin as early as June 15, 2020

OVERVIEW

As early as mid-June, crews will begin building new concrete sidewalks along the east side of 30th Ave NE between NE 137th St and NE 143rd St. This second phase of new sidewalks will make it safer, easier and more pleasant to walk along 30th Ave NE. In the spring of 2019, the Seattle Department of Transportation (SDOT) and Seattle Public Utilities (SPU) completed the first phase of new sidewalks and a Natural Drainage System (NDS) along the east side of 30th Ave NE between NE 130th St and NE 137th St. Additional information be found at www.seattle.gov/transportation/30th-ave-ne.

SCHEDULE

2018-2019: Outreach and design

June 2020-early 2021: Sidewalk construction

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- Sidewalk and curb ramp construction; associated drainage and paving.
- Typical weekday work hours between 7 AM and 5 PM, Monday through Friday
- Lane closures on 30th Ave NE
- Flaggers directing people driving and biking around the work
- Temporary parking restrictions to allows space for work and equipment
- Temporary pedestrian and bike detours around the work zone and staging areas
- Driveway closures when crews are prepping and building sidewalk in front of driveways. We'll notify you individually if you'll be impacted.
- Typical construction noise, dust, and vibrations
