ABOUT THE PROJECT

This Safe Routes to School project will make it safer and easier for kids to walk and bike by improving the intersection at E Lynn St and 19th Ave E near Montlake Elementary School.

TIMING AND BENEFITS

We expect construction will begin in mid-2017. Improvements include:

- Sidewalk restoration to improve walking connections on 19th Ave E and E Lynn St
- An all-way stop to improve the flow of traffic through the intersection
- A curb bulb to shorten the crossing distance for people walking
- Curb ramps for better ADA accessibility
- A raised crosswalk to increase visibility of pedestrians
