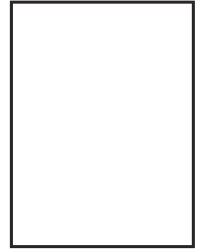

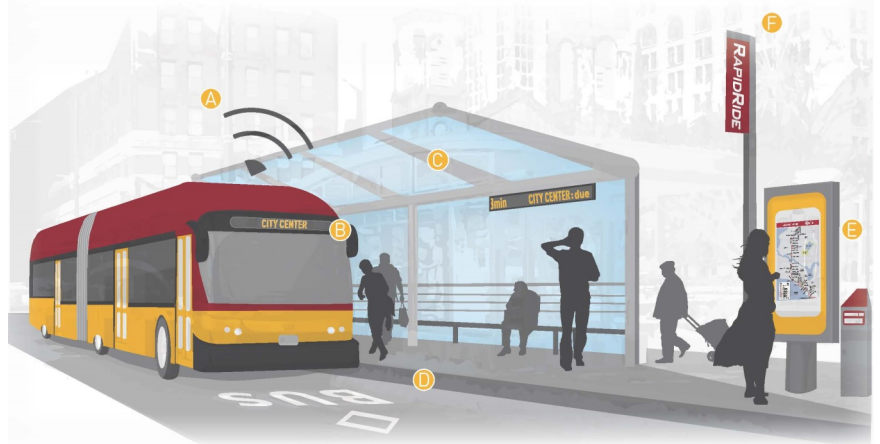

MADISON STREET BRT WILL INCLUDE:

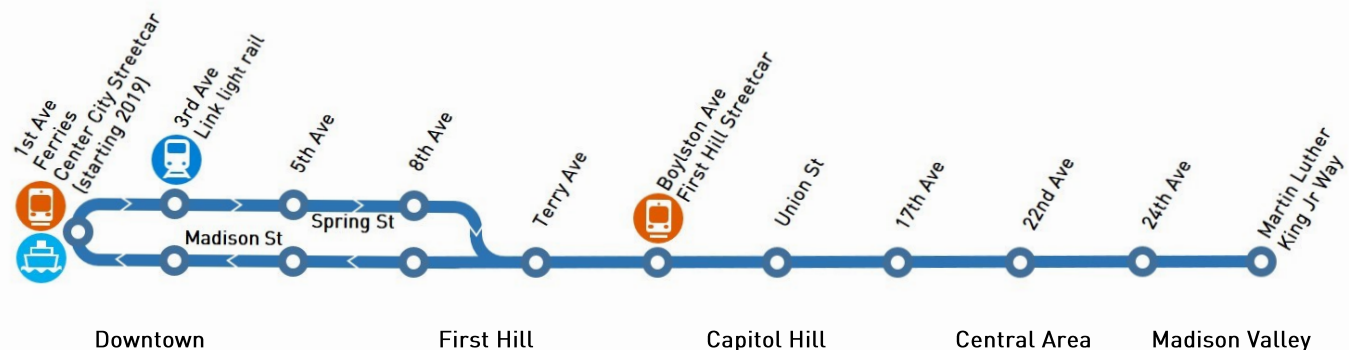
- A. Traffic signal priority for buses
- B. Buses with more capacity and doors
- C. Stations with seating, lighting, weather protection, and real-time displays showing when the next bus will arrive
- D. Platforms that are level with the bus floor
- E. ORCA card readers and ticket vending machines at stations
- F. RapidRide branding so stations stand out

IMPROVEMENTS ON MADISON STREET

We're installing new BRT stations and changing the roadway to prioritize transit. Different sections of the route will have either:

- Bus lanes on the side of the street (while maintaining access to driveways and turns) or
- Dedicated bus lanes in the center of the street
- Or the buses will run in a lane shared with other traffic
