South Park Drainage and Roadway Partnership Project

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Seattle Public Utilities (SPU) and the Seattle Department of Transportation (SDOT) will begin construction of the South Park Drainage and Roadway Partnership project in September. The project will improve chronic flooding and drainage issues in the area by capturing stormwater (rainfall runoff) and directing flows to the future pump station during hightide. The pump station is currently in construction.

SCHEDULE

Construction is expected to begin early September and will last about 12 months. Work hours are Monday through Friday, 6:30 am to 4 pm.

If you have private encroachments in the right of way, such as equipment, retaining system, or bollards, please remove them prior to construction.

LOCATION

Between 2nd Ave S and 8th Ave S, and S Holden St and S Monroe St (See map)

Work will likely happen in this order:

- S Chicago St
- S Monroe St
- S Holden St
- 5th Ave S

ANTICIPATED IMPACTS

You can expect:

- Construction noise, dirt, vibrations, and pavement excavation and removal
- Dewatering and water treatment systems within right-of-way
- Increased construction traffic and staging of large equipment in the area
- Driveway access to private properties to be maintained.
- Driveways may need to be closed for short durations during construction. SPU and contractor will coordinate closures with property owners as needed
- Local access maintained during construction
