

### Drainage Repair Near 8895 Paisley Dr NE SEPA Determination of Non-Significance (DNS)

### **Description of Proposal**

SPU has identified a project that would replace a failing 8-inch diameter corrugated metal pipe culvert located within a steep slope. The culvert collects stormwater runoff from streets and impervious surfaces from adjacent private properties and conveys that water to a Lake Washington tributary (sometimes referred to as Thornton Mainstem Tributary A) that is contained in a piped/culverted system. The failing culvert must be replaced to avoid damaging the steep slope, protect a water main in the same slope, and alleviate flooding risks to homes at the bottom of slope. The project would abandon-in-place the existing culvert and replace it with a partially buried and partially surface-mounted pipe system consisting of 12-inch diameter butt-fused HDPE pipe and 16-inch diameter ductile iron pipe. The work would also replace existing sandbox (catchbasin-like) structures in the street end of NE 88th St and install appurtenances as required. All damaged paved surfaces would be replaced in-kind or as required by SDOT. All disturbed ground not intended to be repaved would be revegetated with native plants.

# Location of Proposal

The project is in public street rights-of-way for NE 88th St and 45th Ave NE in the City of Seattle, Washington (Attachments A and B). At this location, NE 88th St is not a through-street and the remaining affected portions of the rights-of-way for NE 88th St and 45th Ave NE are unimproved and vegetated.

# Lead Agency

Seattle Public Utilities, the lead agency for this proposal, has determined that it does not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment. An environmental impact statement (EIS) is not required under RCW 43.21C.030(2)(c). This decision was made after review of a completed environmental checklist and other information on file with the lead agency. This information is available to the public on request.

This Determination of Non-Significance (DNS) is issued under WAC 197-11-340(2); the lead agency will not act on this proposal for fourteen (14) days from the issuance date below.
