The Governing Board of the Seattle Transportation Benefit District (STBD) will hold a public hearing on Thursday, June 26 at 5:30 p.m. in Seattle City Council Chambers to hear public comment related to placing a vehicle license fee (VLF) and sales and use tax measure before City of Seattle voters for consideration on the November 4 general election ballot. The Board has until August 5 to vote on the proposal that would fund Metro Transit service in Seattle if approved by voters. As part of its ongoing deliberations, the Board is interested in hearing public feedback on the following:

- 1) How would planned Metro Transit service cuts impact you if no action is taken to prevent these cuts?
- 2) What is your perspective on an additional vehicle license fee of up to \$60 and a 0.1% sales and use tax to prevent planned Metro Transit service cuts in Seattle, and if funds allow, to enhance transit service?
- 3) What other information should the Board take into consideration as it develops a potential ballot measure for the November election?
