As the Bicycle Advisory Board for the City of Seattle, we enthusiastically welcome you to our city and wish you an excellent and successful Summit!

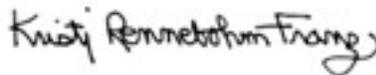
We applaud you as leaders of the present and the future! Your work and activities at this summit can make significant positive differences in all our communities through bicycling.
