Application for Low-Income/Senior/Disability Discount

Purpose and Eligibility: The Cable Discount program was created to help keep basic residential cable television service affordable for all citizens. Eligible customers receive a small monthly discount on their basic cable service. To be eligible, customers must **be a current COMCAST or WAVE cable TV customer*** and meet criteria based on age, disability status and total household income level. For details on eligibility criteria and income guidelines, please see the backside of this sheet.

Certification: I make this Affidavit, under the penalties of perjury, to Comcast/Wave for the purpose of qualifying for a special rate discount for basic residential cable service. I understand that, if I am determined to be eligible, the discount will be effective on the date that this application is accepted. I understand that the discount may not apply to any promotional offer or if my services are incorporated into a value package. Low-Income/Senior/Disability Discount

ELIGIBILITY

Customers meeting the following descriptions may be eligible for a special rate discount for basic residential cable service:

- 65 years or older, or have a disability, with total household Gross Income of less than 70% of the Washington State median; or
- Under age 65 with total household income less than 70% of the State's Median level.
- Must provide proof.

Residents of subsidized (**non-Section 8**) housing are eligible for the discount if they meet income eligibility.

Income eligibility is the same as for the City of Seattle's Utility Discount Program (Seattle City Light and Seattle Public Utilities).

OTHER NOTES

- For both Comcast and Wave customers, the cable discount amount is equivalent to 30% of the price of Comcast's *Limited Basic* TV service. As of February 2016, this equals a \$4.92/month discount. If you have a higher level of TV service, you would receive the \$4.92/month off of that service.
- The cable discount program applies only to cable TV service. It does not apply to internet or phone.
- If you already receive any kind of discount from your cable provider (e.g., a promotional rate or discounted bundle rate), the cable company *will not apply* an additional discount until your existing promotion or discounted package expires.

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
