- The new streetscape design will also enhance the environment of this highly dense urban village.



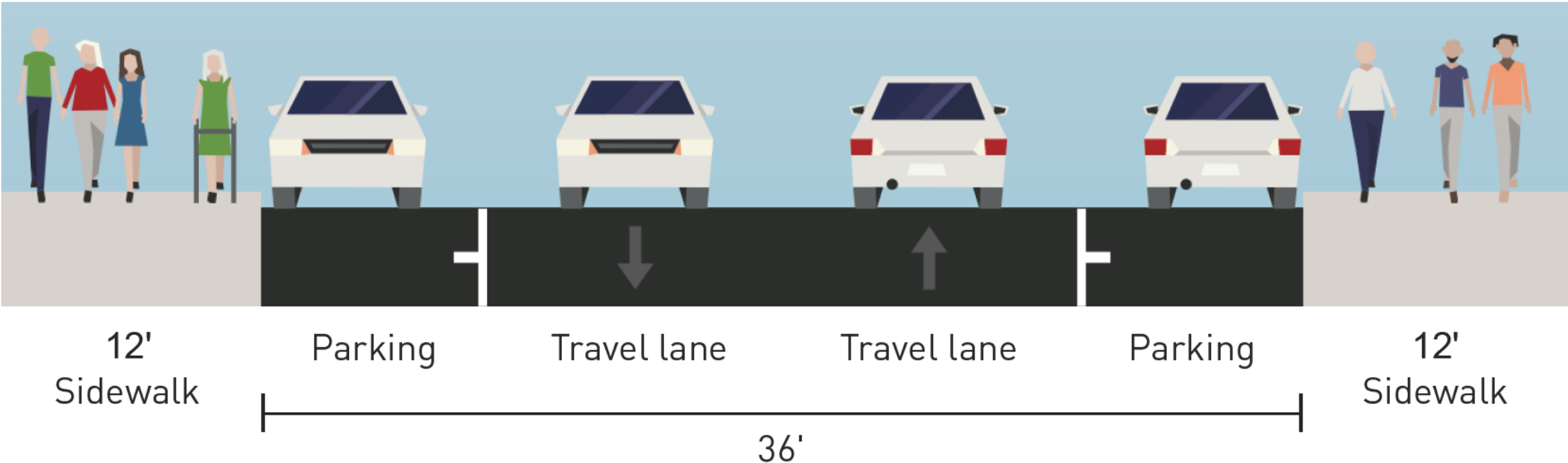
Project area Context Map





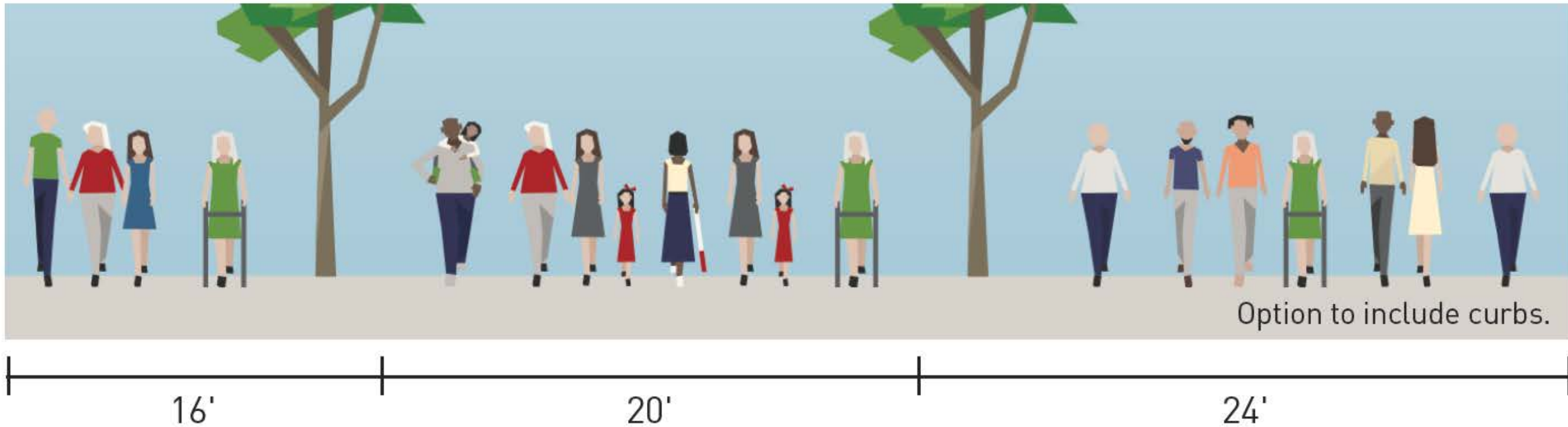

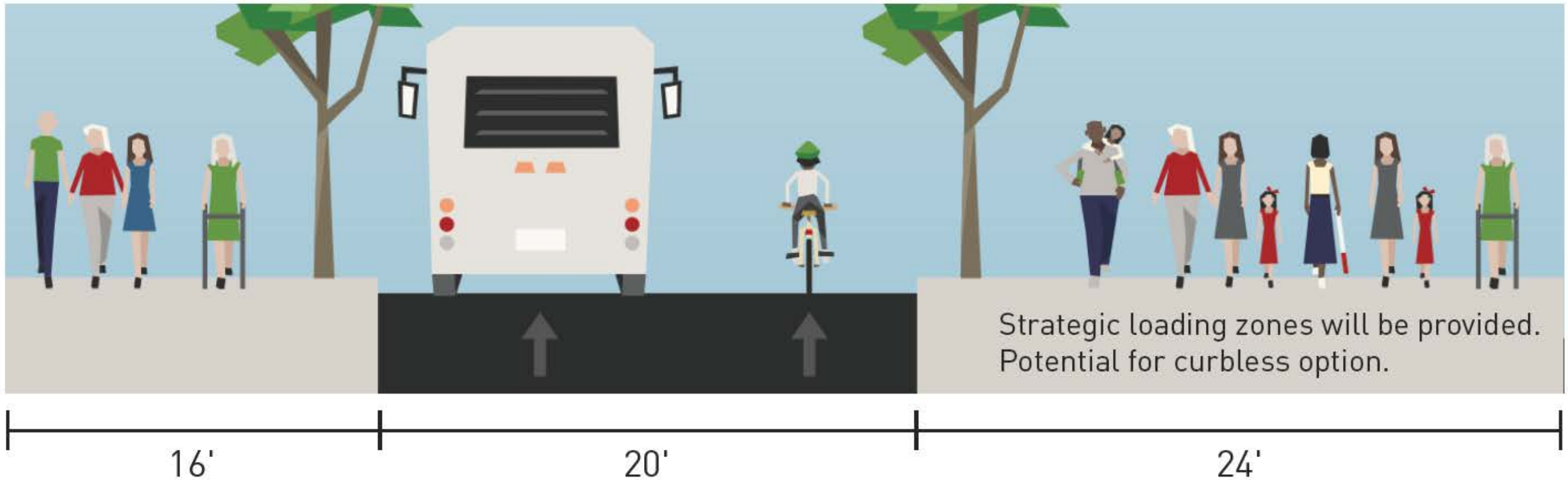
Alternative 1: Pedestrian Only



Option to include curbs.

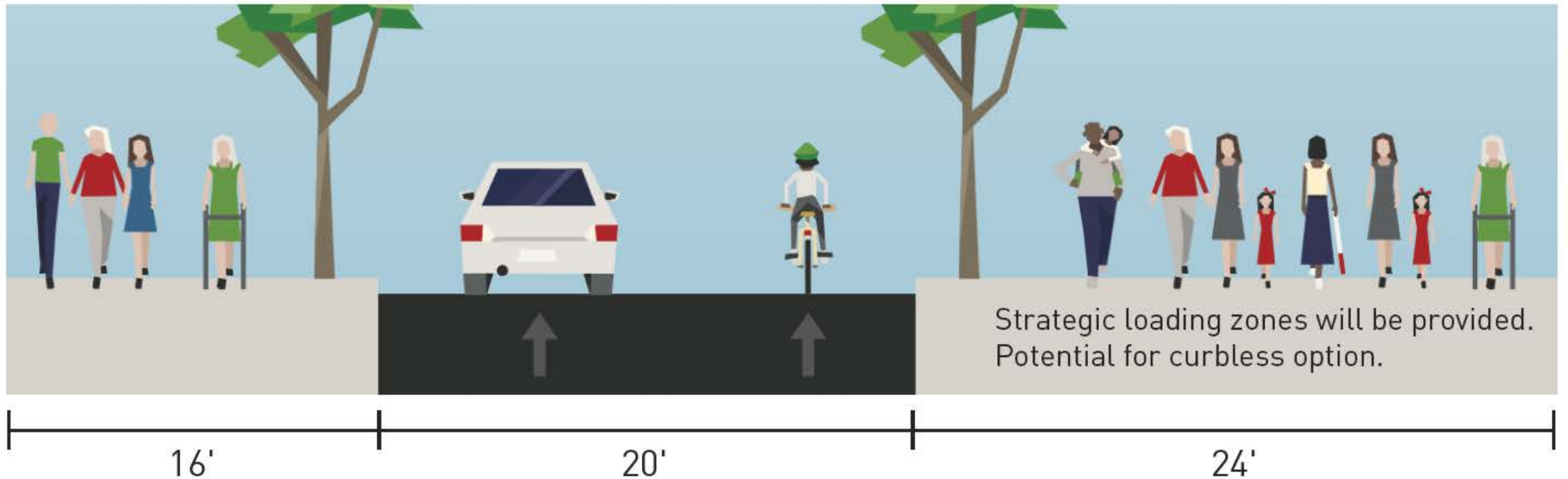
Proposal - Alternative 2

Alternative 2: Westbound One-Way, Transit Only



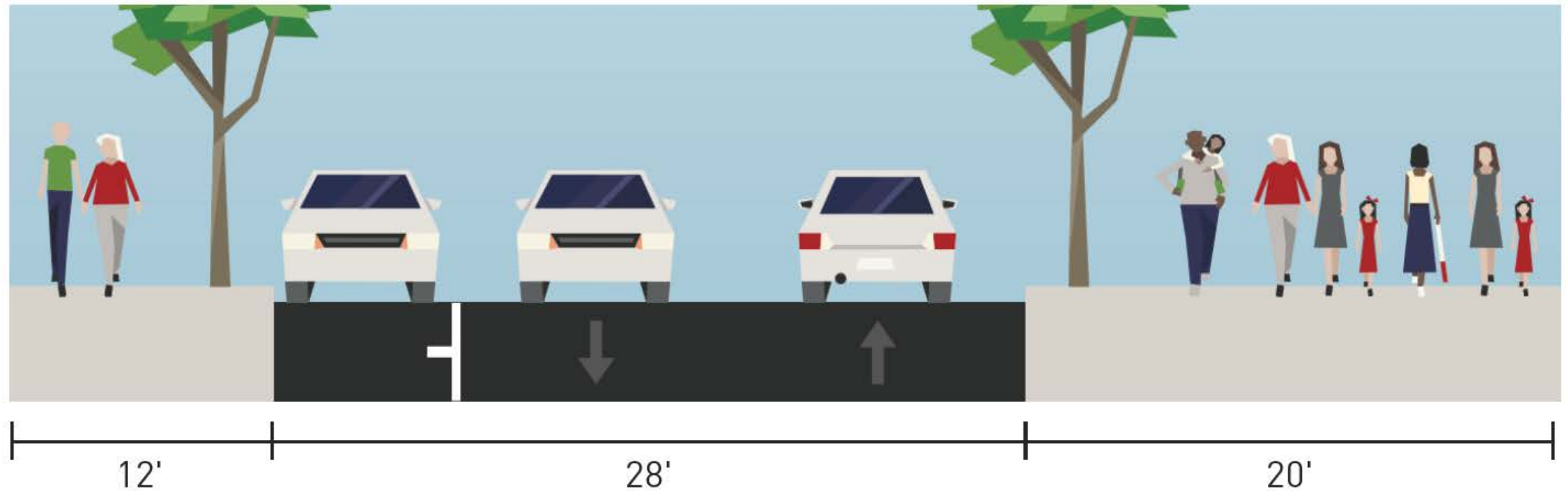
Proposal - Alternative 3
