Freight Master Plan

- Freight master plan is going to likely include design guides based on freight truck street classification
- Are expanding the number of streets with a freight classification
- Are looking at gradations of classifications with different design guidelines
- Are looking at side-guards
- Are looking at intermodal conflicts
- Are looking into high crash locations

- Will come back to us with more details about potential conflicts with pedestrian infrastructure (raised crosswalks, turning radii, lane width)
