


## Corridor projects

- Annual budget = \$2.3 m
- Three to five corridors per year
  - Low-cost corridors
    - 5<sup>th</sup> Ave CBD
    - Boyer Ave
    - 5<sup>th</sup> Ave NE
  - Major corridors
    - Rainier Ave S
    - 23<sup>rd</sup> Ave
    - NE 65<sup>th</sup> St
    - Banner Way/NE 75<sup>th</sup> St




## Corridor projects

- Multiple corridors projects currently in planning/design/study:
  - 35<sup>th</sup> Ave SW
  - Lake City Way
  - Aurora
  - Accessible Mt. Baker
  - MLK
  - Highland Park Way
  - 15<sup>th</sup> NW/Holman Rd
  - Greenwood
  - 12<sup>th</sup> Ave/12<sup>th</sup> Ave E
  - Denny/Elliot

- 20 corridors by 2020
- Focus on Urban Villages
- Speed limit policy review



# Spot projects


- BPSA/Vision Zero
- High collision program
- LPIs and signal visibility
- No turn on red





### Enforcement

- Monthly coordination meetings
- Fatal crash review
- Year-long focus on top contributing factors
  - Impairment
  - Speeding
  - Distraction
  - Failure to yield to ped



### Education

- General VZ campaign
- Major campaigns focus on contributing factors
- Vulnerable communities
- Enforcement support
