### **Project Development Division - Darby Watson**

- New division that helps to take projects from start to finish
- Look at all the modal plans and everything coming through SDOT to see where we can coordinate and leverage funds from various sources
- Joanne: We hope to be able to comment and advise on projects before they are finalized moving forward.
- Darby: May be able to look at draft three-year plan next month.

### **PMP Update (Michelle Marx, Ian Macek)**

- Overall
  - Hope to have materials ready for public review in April
  - After release of plan, need help from Board to spread the word and encourage comments and public comments
- Prioritization
  - Question about including both public and private schools? Michelle: Lack of data is a problem for private schools. Recc: Include only public schools at this time, but Safe Routes to School Program does and will continue to include private schools.
- Performance Standards
  - 12 measures outlined in the 2009 plan - modified for 2016 update
  - Seeking input from board - what should goal be for Measure #3 regarding percent of sidewalks within the Priority Investment Network completed. Ian will send out numbers regarding sidewalks to seek input.
  - Send any additional comments and potential data sources by the end of March to Ian

### **Center City Bike Network (Emily Reardon)**

- Gordon: In replacing the curb bulbs, will you create a pedestrian buffer zone to enforce the turning radius of cars.
- Angela: Consider solution used at Rainier and 55th to create/ increase pedestrian safety.
- Hoping to see less people biking on the sidewalks, Gordon: Will you measure pre- and post- project, to see the change in the number of people biking on sidewalks.

### **Board Business**

- Safe in Magnolia letter - Joanne will update and send around a draft letter for review and edits.
- Rights of Way - Gordon will incorporate final updates and send to the SDOT ROWIM team.
  - VOTE: Jeffrey moves to accept the letter and finalize. Seconded by Catherine. Vote and approval by board.
- Other advisory model boards are working together to compose one letter regarding the Right of Way manual. Gordon will send draft around.
  - VOTE: Angela moves to allow Gordon to finish letter. David G. seconds. Vote and approval by board.
- Currently working to fill final spots on the SPAB board - final interviews coming up, will require City Council and Mayoral approval. City Council vote may happen in May.
- February Minutes
  - VOTE: David G. moved to approve the minutes. Catherine seconds. Vote and approval by board.
