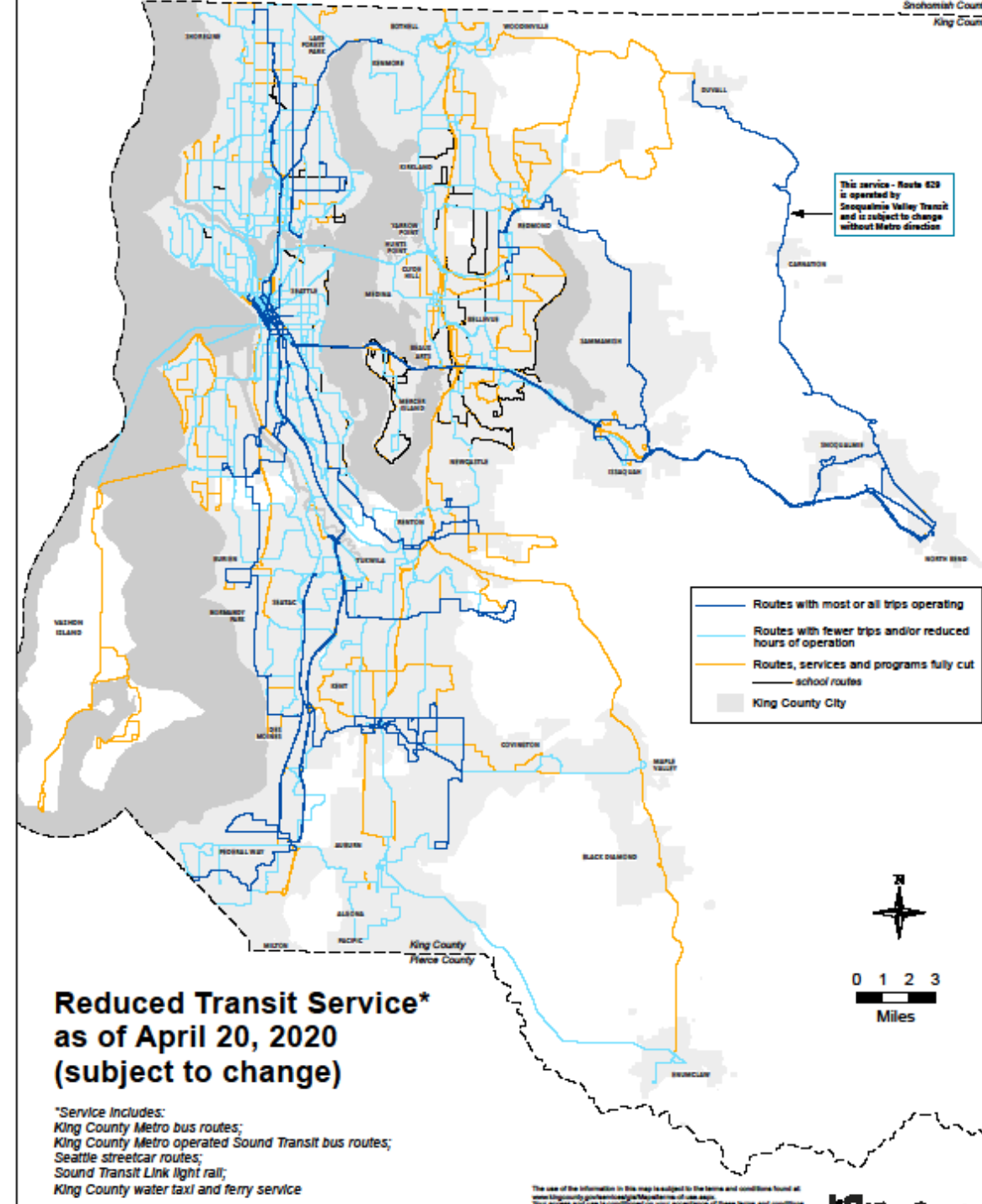

Timeline of Service Changes

- **March 23** – Reduced Service begins
- **April 6** – Reduced Service expanded, most peak commuter routes cancelled
- **April 20** – Reduced Service expanded, additional route and trip reductions

Reduced Service as of April 18, 19, and 20

- **Routes with most or all trips operating:** 34 routes with 2 or fewer trips canceled
- **Routes with fewer trips and/or reduced hours of operation:** 81 routes and services
- **Routes, services and programs fully cut:** 104 routes and services



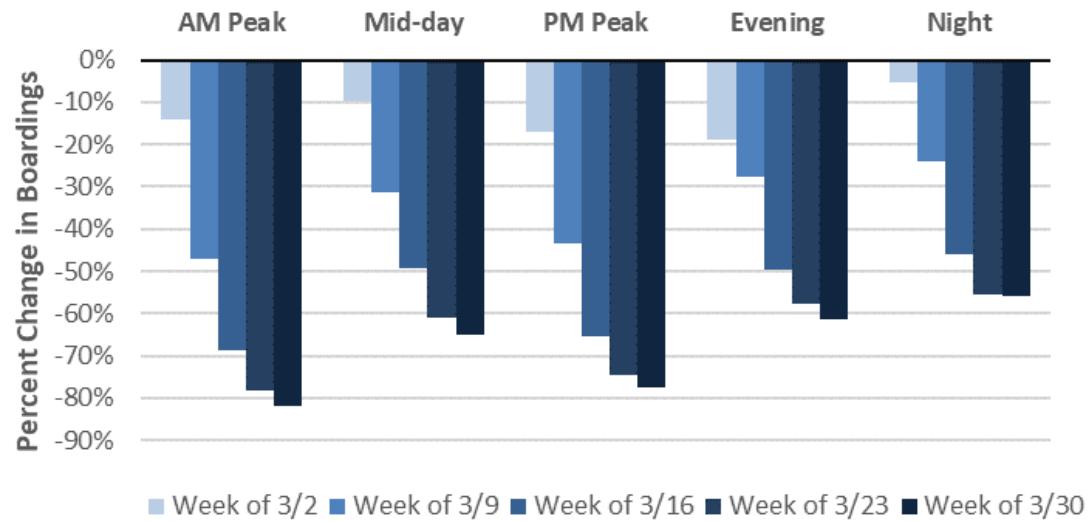
Ridership Changes

Percent Change in Average Daily Boardings over 2019 Baseline

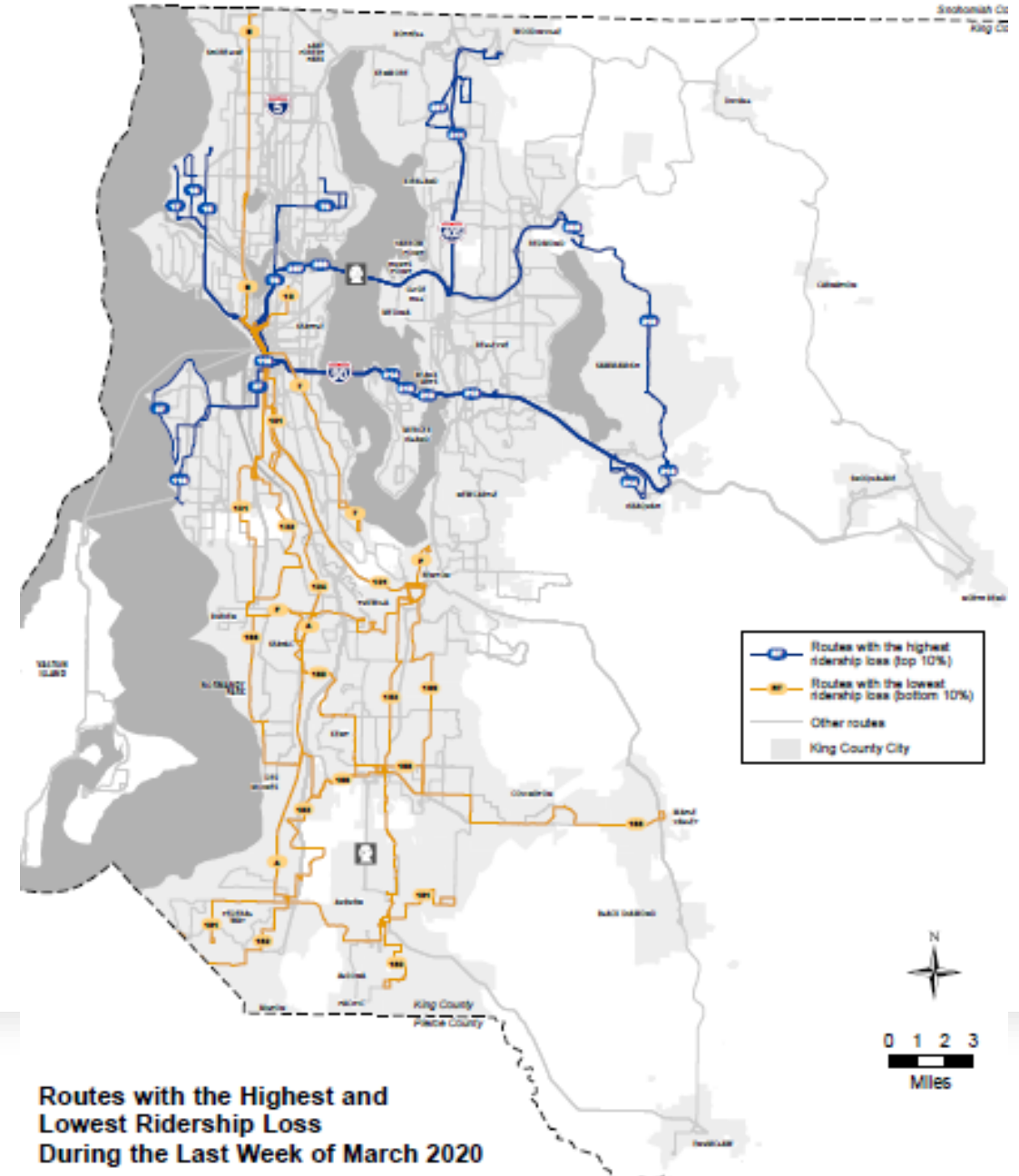


Ridership Changes
