

ORCA OPPORTUNITY PROGRAM



Want an ORCA card?

If you are not eligible for an ORCA card from Seattle Public Schools, you may be eligible for the City of Seattle ORCA Opportunity program. These ORCA cards improve access to school for students that would otherwise walk or pay for transit.

The ORCA cards distributed through this program will be valid September 2019 through August 2020. Income eligibility for this program is consistent with many other programs including: SNAP, Free and Reduced Lunch, and ORCA LIFT. ORCA cards are valid on King County Metro, King County Water Taxi, Seattle Streetcar, Sound Transit, Community Transit, Pierce Transit, Kitsap Transit, and Everett Transit.

ELIGIBILITY EXCEPTIONS

Students that receive specialized transportation are eligible for an ORCA card through the ORCA Opportunity program.

Other eligibility exceptions will be evaluated upon request. Inquiries should be emailed to ORCAOpportunity@seattle.gov.

HOW TO SIGN UP

Students enrolled in the program last year do not need to complete a new application. Students are automatically re-enrolled in the program.

New applicants need to fill out the application and get a parent or legal guardian's signature.

WHERE TO SIGN UP

Students may submit a completed application to the front office of their school or email it to ORCAOpportunity@seattle.gov.

- Be a student in Seattle Public Schools (grades 6 – 8);
- Not currently receive an ORCA card or yellow bus service from Seattle Public Schools; and
- Live in a household that has an income under the amount listed in the table below.
