More buses, more options, more Seattle.

Thanks, Seattle! You voted for better bus service and, as of June 6, 2015, you have it. Now there are more Metro buses, running more hours and to more places every day of the week.

In fact, 85% of all Seattle bus routes are receiving improvements.

It's easier to catch a bus during the middle of the day to shop or go to school.

You don't have to dash from the office to make the "last good bus." And more buses are now running late into the night and on weekends when you have errands to run and places to be.

These improvements, designed and funded by SDOT and implemented by King County Metro, mean that there will be more room on the bus and the bus will come more often. And 70% of the improvements are for Seattle's off-peak bus service, to help you, your neighbors and visitors explore more of the Emerald City.

HIGHLIGHTS

- More buses coming more often
- More routes with buses every 15 minutes or less
- More dependable service, 7 days a week

FUNDING

Seattle residents voted for better bus service when Proposition 1 was approved in November 2014. Every year for the next six years, funds from Proposition 1 will be spent on improved bus service in the city, and to support the ORCA LIFT program, which provides up to a 50% discount on fares for income-qualified riders. The project is funded by a \$60 vehicle license fee and a 0.1% sales tax increase, which went into effect in spring 2015.
