Department: Seattle Center

Urban forestry role: Manage 1000 + trees in a campus-like setting designed for community use and as a festival and event space where large crowds and event setups impact trees.

Urban forestry vision: Maintain and enhance Seattle Center's tree canopy as an important contribution to the green infrastructure of the urban core of the City. Protect and preserve the legacy and dedicated trees throughout the campus for their historic and commemorative value to the community.

- Tree protection
- Tree maintenance

Regulatory role: none

Budget/funding sources:

2012 budget: \$30,000

Funding sources: General Fund (30%), CIP (70%)

Planting: 70% (CIP funded for 2012)

Maintenance: 10%

Pruning:

- Routine: 20%
- Emergency: 0%

Outreach: 0%

Level of Service:

- Prune as needed, in house and using contracted Arborist services
- New trees are generally planted as part of redevelopment projects with CIP funds
