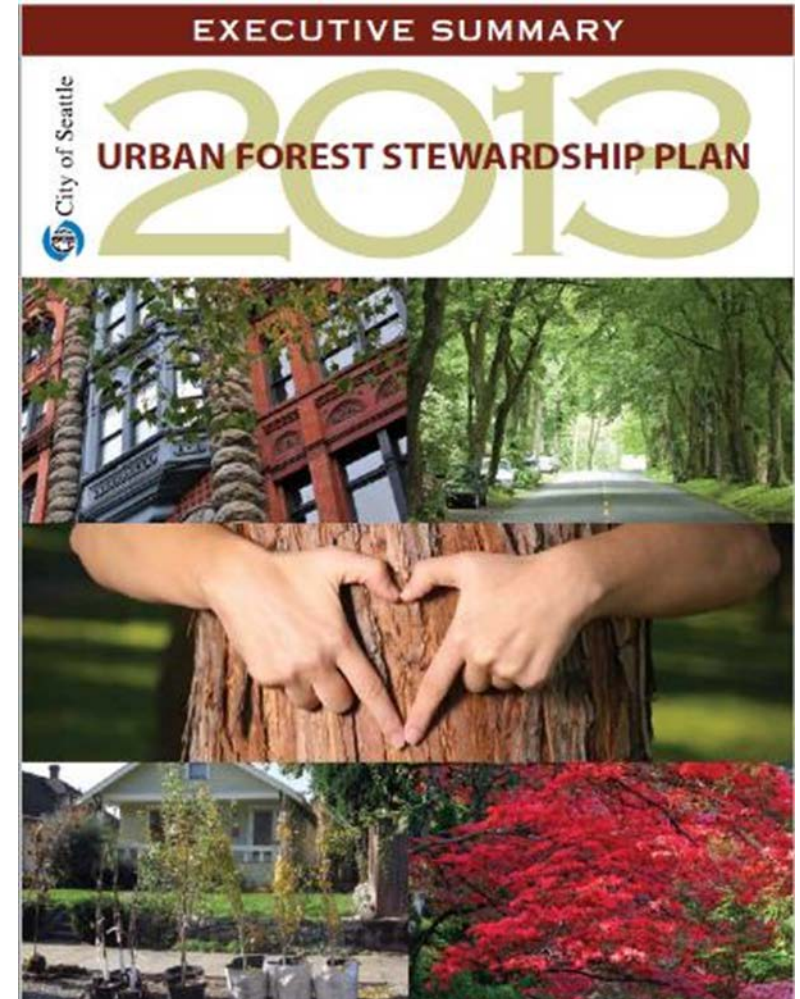

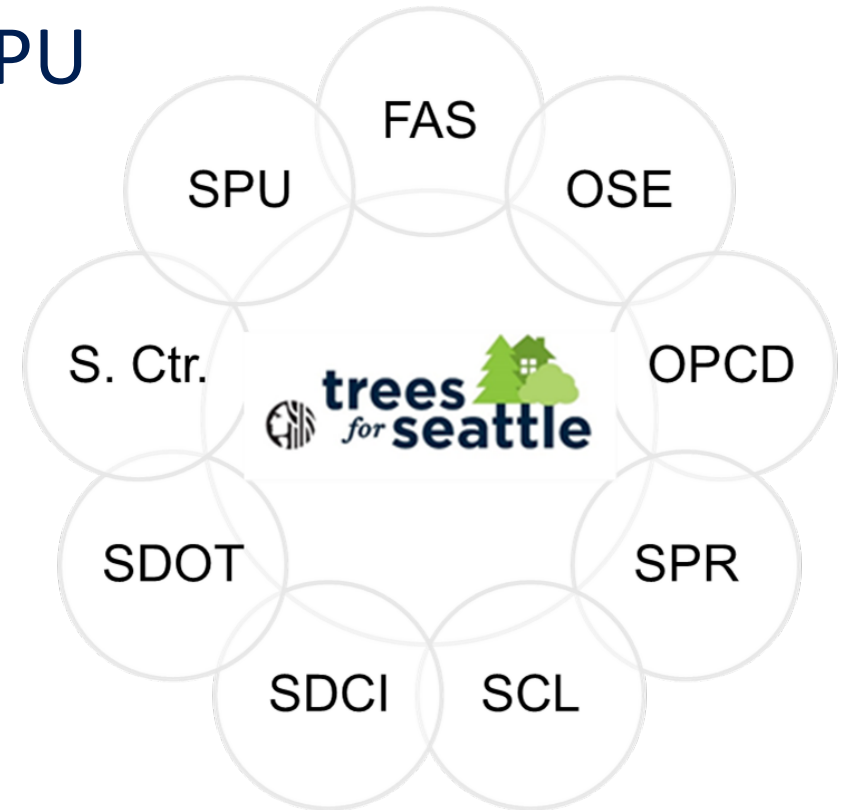

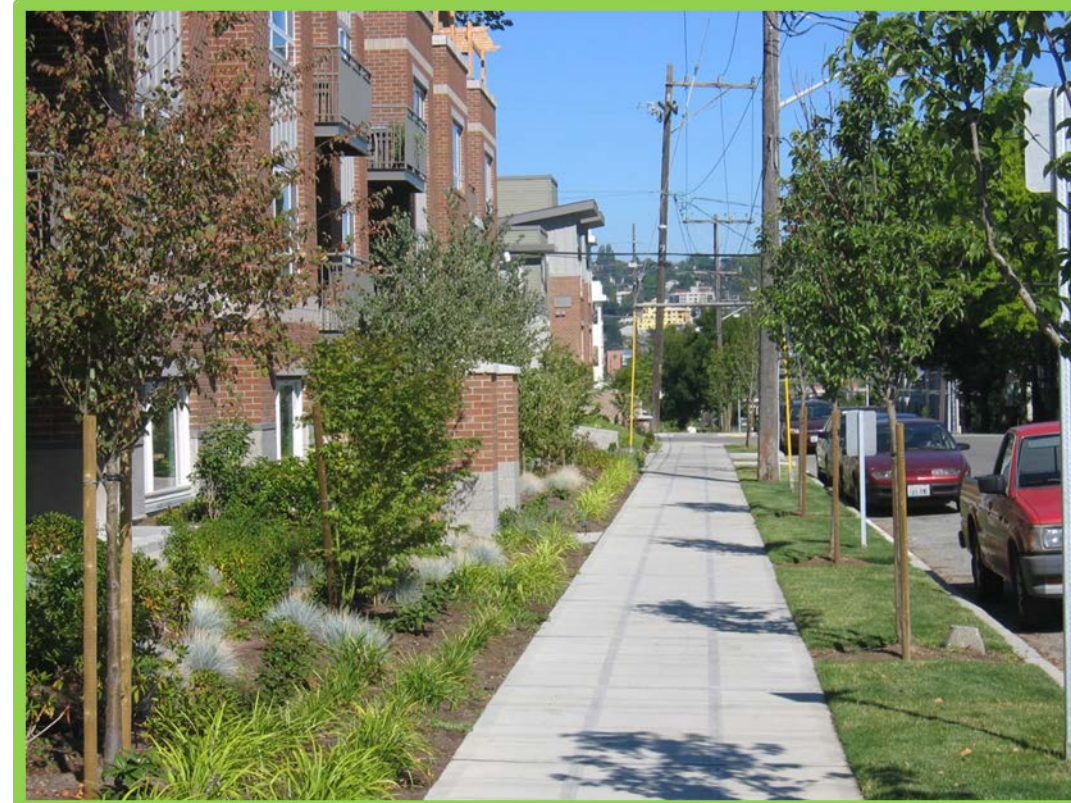
Draft Plan

Public Engagement – Phase II

- Public comment
- Incorporate technical review
- Produce final draft for Mayoral review and approval
- Send to City Council for adoption



Timeline

- Inclusive engagement: July - October, 2018
- Initial assessment: August - October, 2018
- Plan goals, strategies and actions draft: Nov, 2018 - March, 2019
- Draft plan public comment: April - June, 2019
- Final plan production: July - November, 2019
- Submittal to Mayor's Office for adoption: November, 2019
