- No felony record charges
- Clear background check
- CPR certification (Training will be provided prior to start of class)
- Washington State Driver's License
- Recipient must be able to provide transportation to and from classes and clinical sites

Information

- Public Health Emergency Medical Services will supply needed equipment
- The selected candidates must pass a background investigation
- The selected candidates must have selected immunizations. Arrangements can be made with Emergency Medical Services to acquire these
