**PERMIT CONDITIONS**

If permit is approved, the permit holder has permission to move containers of hazardous materials as listed in Section 3, above, through the marine terminal facility listed in Section 1, above. This temporary special permit shall become valid and expire in accordance with the inspector's signature and dates as listed. This shipment of hazardous cargo shall be in conformance with the provisions of the current Title 49 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), the Seattle Fire Code, and the SFD Administrative Rule 27.01 related to marine terminals. Particular attention shall be paid to the following items:

1. Container(s) shall be stored with placards visible on all four sides of the containers.
2. Any spill, release of product, or fire shall be immediately reported to the Seattle Fire Department by dialing 9-1-1.
3. Shipping papers and other required documents shall be available for review in the jobsites office as listed above in Section 1.
4. Call the Marine Terminals Office at (206) 386-1340 with any questions or changes in the scheduled shipment.
