

Resolution 28948

A RESOLUTION amending Resolution 28115 with the intent of changing the representation to the City Neighborhood Council and clarifying documentation requirements for the City Neighborhood Council.

WHEREAS, the City Council established the Neighborhood Planning and Assistance Program by adopting Resolution 27709 on October 26, 1987; and

WHEREAS, the City Council amended Resolution 27709 by passing Resolution 28115 on December 18, 1989 for the purpose of creating a Downtown District and broadening representation on District Councils as well as on the City Neighborhood Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Neighborhood Council is in need of revitalization as evidenced by a lack of a quorum for most meetings over an extended period of time; and

WHEREAS, a committee studying the options for revitalization has recommended that the representation to the City Neighborhood Council be changed to be the District Council Chair or a designated alternate; and

WHEREAS, all of Attachment A is in need of review and updating, but there is no formal group to do this as the City Neighborhood Council has not had a quorum; and

WHEREAS, the District Chairs are willing to accept the roles assigned to the City Neighborhood Council; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEATTLE:

That Section 3 of Attachment A shall be revised as follows:

3. City Neighborhood Council (CNC)

a. Each District Council *Chair or a designated alternate*, shall ~~select one residential and one business district representative to~~ serve on a City Neighborhood Council. Additional positions may be added by the City Neighborhood Council, as needed, in order to make the membership reflective of the City's diverse population.

b. The responsibilities of the City Neighborhood Council shall include i) review and recommendations regarding City budget issues including the general fund, capital and block grant budgets and the Neighborhood Matching Fund; ii) advice on policies necessary to the effective and equitable implementation of the Neighborhood Planning and Assistance Program.


c. The Council shall be staffed by the ~~City's Office~~ Department of Neighborhoods, with responsibilities as designated for District Councils. Actions of the City Neighborhood Council shall be documented in an official public record and maintained at the Department of Neighborhoods.
