Animal access is not permitted in wading pool or on swimming beaches.

No running and no water fights.

Children younger than 13 must be supervised by a responsible adult.

SAVE WATER... USE THE WADING POOLS!

As an element of the City's water conservation effort, we're encouraging people to use public wading pools rather than fill their home "kiddy pools" or run backyard sprinklers. In accordance with state law, we fill, supervise, and empty each wading pool every day, which requires a substantial amount of water. With a bit of analysis, we learned that filling home wading pools uses more water than a public community wading pool. For example, if 50 families used the East Queen Anne wading pool at 160 Howe St., rather than filling their home wading pools, the water saved would equal that needed to fill the public wading pool, which would serve a lot more than 50 kids!

We will plan to open the wading pools on sunny days when the temperature is forecast to be **70 degrees or above**. On most days we will fill them half full, which is a 50% water savings....but on the busiest days they will be filled to the top!

Wading Pools	Bitter Lake	13035 Linden ave N	7/29-9/7	Noon-7p.m.	<p>Seattle Parks and Recreation will operate 14 wading pool sites in the summer of 2009, rather than the usual 25, because of the need to complete federally required safety improvements required by the Virginia Graeme Baker Pool and Spa Safety Act. Parks is working to obtain permits and to install this safety equipment on wading pools. Unfortunately, 11 wading pools will not open in 2009 because Parks cannot complete the required drain work on all pools before the end of the summer.</p> <p>The Act requires that we install specified new drain covers and second anti-entrapment systems to protect the public from possible injury or death caused by getting caught in pool drains. Because of the nationwide demand for the drain covers and anti-entrapment systems and the skilled labor required to install them, there are delays in the work all over the country.</p> <p>Public safety comes first. Parks apologizes for the inconvenience to wading pool users, and has tried hard to achieve geographic balance in order to provide an operating wading pool or water spray feature within a reasonable distance of everyone in the city. Once the modifications are completed, each of the 14 wading that can be updated will operate every day and run through Labor Day, weather permitting.</p> <p>These are the 11 pools that will not operate during the summer of 2009. Beacon Hill, Georgetown, Gilman, Highland Park, Magnuson, North Acres, Peppi's, Powell Barnett, Ravenna, Sandel, Soundview. Again we apologize for the inconvenience.</p>
