

CONSTRUCTION ALERT

Fairview Ave E Intersection & Trail Improvements

July to September 2012

Construction starting July 9, 2012 Expect parking restrictions

The Seattle Department of Transportation (SDOT) will be constructing a new sidewalk and other pedestrian improvements on Fairview Ave E. Work is scheduled to begin in July 9 and is expected to be completed by early September, weather permitting.

This project is part of the “**Bridging the Gap**” transportation levy approved by Seattle voters in November 2006 and funded by the Neighborhood Street Fund (NSF), a city-administered program that works with communities to prioritize and build neighborhood projects.

Project area

Fairview Ave E between Fairview Ave N and E Blaine Street

Project elements

As part of the Cheshiahud Lake Union Loop Trail, the project will build a 6 foot asphalt walkway along the waterside of Fairview Ave E and connect to the existing asphalt walkway at E Blaine Street.

Safety improvements will be made at the intersection of Fairview Ave E and Fairview Ave N:

- Squaring up the intersection to reduce the crossing distance for pedestrians crossing Fairview Ave E
- Building sidewalk on either side of the intersection
- Reducing the southbound lane width of Fairview Ave N
- Adding on-street parking to Fairview Ave N in the project area
- Adding bicycle facilities along Fairview Ave N

What to Expect During Construction:

- Typical work hours 7 am to 6 pm; Mon-Fri
- Parking and loading restrictions in project area
- Selective tree and vegetation removal
- Traffic and pedestrian detours
- Moderate construction noise and dust
