

SEPA DETERMINATION OF NON-SIGNIFICANCE (DNS)
SEATTLE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION
YESLER BRIDGE REHABILITATION PROJECT

Description of proposal: The Seattle Department of Transportation (SDOT) plans to rehabilitate the existing Yesler Way Bridge, which was originally constructed in 1910. The work will include removal of steel columns that support the existing three-span structure and replacement with a single span structure, rehabilitation of the east abutment wall, replacement of the west abutment wall, and reconstruction of the northwest staircase. SDOT will rehabilitate and preserve the key historic features of the bridge. In addition SDOT will improve intersection design to increase user safety and to meet ADA requirements.
