


Q1 What grade is your child in? (If you have more than one child, please answer these questions about your OLDEST child at this school).



Q2 Is your child a boy or a girl?



Q3 Has your child ever walked or biked to the school campus? (Please check all that apply)



Q4 How safe do you feel letting your child walk or bike to school, on a scale from 1 to 5?



Q5 Does your child know how to ride a bike?



Q6 How confident are you that your child knows the rules of the road while biking, on a scale from 1 to 5?















Q12 How much do you agree or disagree with the following statements?







Q14 What most closely describes your child’s ethnic identity?


