The funds will be used to purchase refreshments, bike decorating supplies, prizes to reward participation in walking and biking, notices about the events, and bike tuning supplies.
Franklin High School	2	\$1,000.00	Friends of Mt Baker Town Center will install art on the Mt Baker Pedestrian Bridge that connects Franklin High School to the Mt Baker Light Rail Station, including paint, "story gates," and wayfinding vinyl wraps.
Green Lake Elementary School	6	\$1,000.00	Green Lake Elementary School PTA will use these funds to provide a bike education assembly, bike rodeo, bike helmets and lights, and basic safety education materials.
Wedgwood Elementary School	5	\$750.00	Girl Scout Troop 40157 will use these funds to install crossing flags and buckets for six intersections serving the Wedgwood Elementary School area, a crosswalk and bicycling awareness program, and flyers, posters, refreshments, and reflectors for walking and biking safety.
Hamilton International Middle School	4	\$1,000.00	The HIMS Green Team will use these funds to improve the safety of traffic circulation around the school by placing reflective sandwich boards with blinking lights at four street entrances. The project will also include large paper signs advertising Safe Routes to School safety tips and events, backpack reflectors and other prizes for student participation in Safe Routes to School events, and crossing flags and flag holders.

Funds will also be used to purchase reflectors and SRTS maps for each family.
