

## *What's New at the Edmunds / Columbia City Station Area*

Edmunds Station is located on MLK between South Edmunds and Alaska Streets. The Edmunds Station will be a gateway to the Rainier Vista redevelopment and historic Columbia City, the key shopping and cultural center of the community. The station will have small-scale, neighborhood-supporting retail and services nearby, and will help fulfill the neighborhood's desire for ongoing reinvestment and entrepreneurship.

The redevelopment of Rainier Vista into a mixed income community of homeowners and renters provides an opportunity to strengthen the already vibrant residential neighborhood. Seattle Housing Authority is currently in early design stages for Rainier Vista. Station Area Planners are working closely with

Seattle Housing Authority to ensure that design efforts led by Sound Transit are tightly coordinated with the Rainier Vista design process. Look for their frequent Design Review meetings, coming soon to a community center near you!

Clear pedestrian routes will connect Rainier Vista, Edmunds Station, and the commercial core of Columbia City. Sound Transit will make improvements along Edmunds Street as a part of their light rail project. These improvements will reflect the Columbia City historic district and include wider sidewalks, street trees, and pedestrian-scale lighting.
