## Construction and associated traffic changes began September 28 at Lake City Way NE and NE 110th St

### Construction Update

On **Monday, September 28**, crews working for the Seattle Department of Transportation began constructing safety and transit improvements at Lake City Way NE and NE 110th St. The work will be completed in 3 phases:

1. September 28 – early November: New sidewalk, curb ramps, and bus stop improvements in Work Zone 1
2. Early to late November: Wider sidewalk, new in-lane bus stop, and other bus stop improvements in Work Zone 2
3. Late November to mid-December: New pedestrian island and pedestrian countdown signals in Work Zone 3

To complete the work safely and efficiently, crews will close portions of Lake City Way NE and NE 110th St as shown in the map below.

### What You Can Do

- Remove items in the public right of way
- Follow posted detours and “No Parking” signs
- Keep a safe distance from the work zone

### TRAFFIC CHANGES: LAKE CITY WAY NE AND NE 110TH ST SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS

**WORK ZONE 1**  
SEPT. 28 - EARLY NOV. (LANE AND NE 110TH ST CLOSED)

**WORK ZONE 2**  
EARLY - LATE NOV. (LANE CLOSED)

**WORK ZONE 3**  
LATE NOV. - MID-DEC. (AREA CLOSED)

### WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- Weekday work hours, 7 AM to 6 PM
- Some early morning, evening, or weekend work may be needed
- Closure of NE 110th St through early November
- Left-turn restrictions onto NE 110th St for southbound traffic on Lake City Way NE in late November to mid-December
- Temporary bus stop relocations
  - Northbound (Sept. 28 to early Nov.)
  - Southbound (Early to late Nov.)
- Temporary, short-term driveway interruptions in the work zone
- Sidewalk detours and parking restrictions
- Noise, dust, and vibration
