

**SEPA DETERMINATION OF NON-SIGNIFICANCE (DNS)  
SEATTLE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION  
2009 ARTERIAL ASPHALT AND CONCRETE PROGRAM: FAUNTLEROY WAY**

**Description of proposal:** As part of its 2009 Arterial, Asphalt, and Concrete Program, the City of Seattle, Department of Transportation (SDOT) proposes a maintenance project to resurface and repair the damaged portions of the roadway for Fauntleroy Way in Seattle, WA.

Proposed work includes center-lane hot mix asphalt (HMA) removal and replacement, overlay and concrete panel replacement, intermittent base repair, replacement or repair of curb ramps and portions of curb and sidewalks, and installation of stormwater catch basins. The project also intends to improve access for bicyclists by channelizing the traffic from four vehicular traffic lanes to three and adding sharrows in the remaining space.

**Location of proposal:** The current roadway footprint of Fauntleroy Way SW between SW Alaska St and SW Holly St..


**Lead Agency:** SDOT

This DNS is issued under WAC 197-11-340(2) and Seattle Municipal Code (SMC) 25.05.340; the lead agency will not act on this proposal for 14 days from the issue date below. **Comments must be submitted by 5:00 p.m. Jan. 5, 2009.**
