E Yesler Way & 18th Ave S Sidewalk Repair Project

Project Planned for February 2014


The Seattle Department of Transportation (SDOT) will replace broken and uplifted sections of sidewalk along E Yesler Way and 18th Ave S. Work is planned to begin in February.

Project Elements

- Remove and replace damaged sidewalk at these locations:
 - The south side of E Yesler Way, east of 18th Ave S
 - The east side of 18th Ave S, south of E Yesler Way
 - At the southwest and northeast corners of E Yesler Way and 18th Ave S.
- Remove and replace 9 street trees in poor condition: 7 along E Yesler Way and 2 along 18th Ave S.
- For each tree removed SDOT will plant one tree in its place and a second tree at another location in the neighborhood.
- 72 hours before the work starts, "No Parking" signs will be placed on E Yesler Way and 18th Ave S.

Actions for Residents

- Please contact SDOT** if you have any information that may be useful for this project. For example, timing of special events or deliveries, special needs of users of the sidewalk, etc.
- Adjacent property owners are required to **trim vegetation** to leave a 1 foot space between the sidewalk and the vegetation. This is necessary for workers to remove and replace the sidewalk.



- SDOT is not responsible for damage to private property in the public right-of-way** such as landscaping, artwork or sprinkler systems in the planting strip or on the sidewalk. Property owners may wish to remove such items before the project begins.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- Bus stop will be relocated temporarily
- Parking restrictions on E Yesler Way and 18th Ave S
- Pedestrian detours
- Moderate construction noise & dust
- Tree removal and replacement
- Normal work hours will be 8am – 4 pm Mon. – Fri.
- Access will be maintained to businesses and residences.
