

## W Boston Street at Queen Anne Avenue N Sidewalk Repair Project

The Seattle Department of Transportation (SDOT) will replace broken and uplifted sections of concrete sidewalk and curbs on the south side of W Boston Street west of Queen Anne Avenue N. The work will start just west of Queen Anne Avenue N on the southwest corner at West Boston Street and extend westward across the alley to include a short length of sidewalk west of the alley.

### Schedule


- Work will begin Wednesday July 30.
- The project is estimated to take approximately three weeks.

### Project Elements

- Saw concrete and break and remove existing sidewalk
- Prune tree roots
- Enlarge tree pits
- Install new sidewalks

### Actions for Residents and Businesses

- **Please contact SDOT** if you have any information that may be useful for this project. For example, timing of special events or deliveries, special needs of users of the sidewalk, etc.
- Adjacent businesses are required to remove all outdoor seating, containerized plants, signage, etc. from the sidewalk on W Boston Street.
- The temporary closure of the alley entrance may require route changes. Please be patient with our work.
- Adjacent property owners are required to **trim vegetation** to leave a 1 foot space between the sidewalk and the vegetation. This is necessary for workers to remove and replace the sidewalk.
- **SDOT is not responsible for damage to private property in the public right-of-way** such as landscaping, artwork or sprinkler systems in the planting strip or on the sidewalk. Property owners may wish to remove such items before the project begins.



### WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- 72 hours before the work starts and parking restrictions begin, "No Parking" signs will be placed on the south side of W Boston Street.
- The entrance to the alley south of W Boston St and west of Starbucks will be closed starting Mon. Aug. 4. It will re-open by 11:30 AM Thurs. Aug. 7, before the entrance on the other end of this alley (north of W Crockett St) is closed on Thursday afternoon for the farmers' market.
- Pedestrian detours
- Work hours: 7 AM – 3 PM Mon. – Fri.
- Construction noise & dust
- Access will be maintained to businesses and residences.
