- Entry curb completed
- Plaza planters installed and filled with dirt
- New 2nd Ave. S Ext./S Jackson St. structural column support installed

STATION INTERIOR

- Clock adjusted for daylight savings
- Historic marble replaced in restored ticket room
- Historic windows refurbished and reinstalled
- Transformer delivered and electrical gear installed

Plaza granite salvaged on-site, reused.




Another use for salvaged granite.
