Description: A steeply sloped triangle defined by steps, ramp and street. Landscaped with drought-tolerant flowering plants and evergreen shrubs, in design of triangles within triangles. Replaced previous tangled mess of blackberries, weeds, grass and dumping area for trash.

2004 Plant List: Russian Sage, Purple and White Spanish Lavenders, Ceanothus, Pink Rock Rose, Purple and White Cone Flower, Hardy Geraniums, Pink Missouri Primrose, Coreopsis Moonbeam and C. Early Sunrise, Blue Salvia, Parahebe, Lupines, Lamb ears, Purple Asters, Ornamental grasses, Blue Star Spruce, Japanese Cryptomeria, and Rose of Sharon

SDOT observations:

Hard to garden steep slope site. Plants are filling in. Nicely mulched with beauty bark. The garden upslope (not included with nomination) is maintained by a gardener hired by the abutting homeowner. Overall an example of a well maintained stairway garden.
