

Parking Just Got Easier!

The SEATTLE DEPARTMENT of TRANSPORTATION has a new approach to ensuring access in downtown and neighborhood business districts with on-street paid parking.

The **SeaPark** system provides neighborhood visitors and shoppers with easier, and more convenient on-street parking. Below are new programs to help make your next parking experience easier.

◀ AFTER 5PM

In nine neighborhoods, parking hours extend to 8 pm to support reliable visitor access. On blocks where signs show this icon, the maximum parking time limit is extended from 2 hours to 3 hours after 5 pm. **After 5 pm, you can park until 8 pm and stay all evening.**

VALUE



◀ BEST VALUE

Look for the green check mark to find the Best Value parking blocks, with **lower rates or longer time limits**. These blocks may be a little farther from your destination but likely have more parking available, making it easier to find a spot.

Park it.



◀ PRE-PAYMENT OPTION

Parking stickers for the following morning are available **starting at 10 pm** the previous night. Go home by cab or bus and retrieve your vehicle the next morning.

◀ PAY BY MOBILE PHONE

The City is adding **pay by mobile phone** features that will allow you to pay for parking by phone – you can even add time or receive notifications that your time is almost up. Look for this new feature this fall.
